
PROMOTIONAL OPPORTUNITY OFFERED BY THE

100 YEARS OF POLAND'S REGAINED INDEPENDENCE. POLISH HISTORY IN FILM MASTERPIECES PROGRAMME IN VIETNAM



To mark the centenary of Poland's regained independence, the Polish Filmmakers Association is holding a series of block screenings of films encompassing works of indisputable artistic and historical worth, particularly those which tackle the topic of the fight for freedom.

The 100 Years Poland's Regained of Independence. Polish in Film History Masterpieces initiative was conceived in order to promote Polish history and art within the international arena. The canon of seven works offers audiences around the world both a wide thematic spectrum and a diversity of aesthetics. It shows various historical periods, from Poland under the Partitions, via the Second World War and the Warsaw Uprising, to the post-war fight against the communist authorities. The works selected for the programme provide an insight into Polish history from the viewpoint of several generations, ranging from Andrzej Wajda, now

a classic figure of Polish cinema, to **Jan Komasa**, a representative of our youngest filmmakers. They also include **Roman Polański's** *The Pianist*.

To mark the occasion, the Polish Filmmakers Association has compiled a special publication in the form of a catalogue containing brief essays intended to give foreign audiences an insight into the particular historical context within which the action of each film is set. During the screenings in Vietnam, the catalogue will be distributed in three cities; **Hanoi, Da Nang and Ho Chi Minh**. In Hanoi, the distribution will take place at the prestigious **Hanoi International Film Festival**.

The international screenings of the seven films are supported by the President of the Republic of Poland, Andrzej Duda, who wrote the letter which opens the catalogue. The Polish-Vietnamese Parliamentary Group and the Vietnamese-Polish Parliamentary Group are patrons of the event and representatives of both groups will be attending the screenings, which also enjoy the patronage of the Vietnamese-Polish Friendship Society and the Polish-Vietnamese Friendship Association,
