After one year of operation, on March 05th 2015, the Central & Eastern European Chamber of Commerce in Vietnam (CEEC) organized its Extraordinary Annual Meeting (EGM) and Annual General Meeting (AGM) 2016



Corporate, individual and advisory committee members joined this occasion and showed their continuously support for feed (21 participants and 7 proxies).

Following the greetings from CEEC's Chairman, Mr. Marko Moric, Mr. Csaba Bundik (CEEC's Vice Chairman), on behalf the Executive Committee, presented the suggested changes in CEEC's Statutes 2015. All members voted and unanimously approved the new 2016 Statutes.

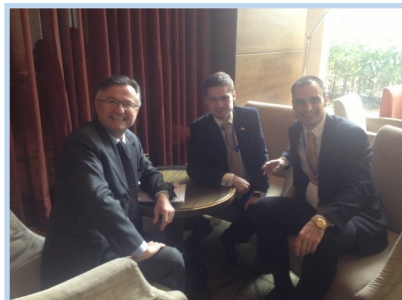

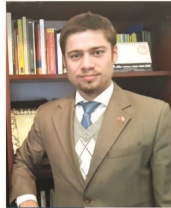

# Vietnam Economic Times – The Next Level Awaits: Potential of economic ties between Vietnam and Poland

## NEXT LEVEL AWAITS

*Mr. Mariusz Boguszeowski, Economic Counselor at the Embassy of Poland and Chairman of the Advisory Committee of the Central & Eastern European Chamber of Commerce in Vietnam (CEEC), spoke with VET about the potential of economic ties between Vietnam and Poland.*

■ **Poland was one of first countries to establish diplomatic relations with Vietnam. What have been the major achievements in economic, trade and investment cooperation between the two countries over recent years?**

There is no one main achievement we can mark. We have experienced many achievements in the past in economic cooperation. Last year, according to figures now available, bilateral trade turnover increased significantly, growing at the highest rate among all Southeast and East Asian countries (including China, Japan and South Korea). If this trend continues in 2016 Vietnam will become Poland's largest trade partner in ASEAN, ahead of Singapore.

Among last year's achievements I must mention an agreement over our phytosanitary services, which allows Polish apples into the Vietnamese market. We held several successful promotional activities, including the "European meat - tradition, quality and taste" campaign, the business mission led by the Deputy Minister of Economy, Ms. Henclewska, and business seminars and publications.

If we look deeper into the last ten years we have seen continuous growth in trade turnover, at more than 10 per cent every year, except for 2009, when it fell. We can also observe growing interest among investors. I hope that after the liberalization of Vietnam's investment regulations that Polish companies will be more active in this field.

We have a long tradition of cooperation in heavy industry, mining and shipbuilding, as well as pharmaceuticals and agro-food. We also have a long tradition and major potential for the future, in connected fields

such as science and especially higher education.

■ **Some insiders say that two-way trade turnover between Poland and Vietnam is still at a modest rate compared to the potential and historic relations between the two countries. What are your thoughts on this?**

It is true that our potential is great. We are working hard on it and the results are visible already. As I mentioned, we have achieved relatively high and stable growth in our bilateral trade turnover for the last few years, though I agree that we could expect higher increases. Our companies must learn more quickly how to adjust to the changing circumstances because competition in the globalized economy is very strong. Vietnam has become party to many bilateral and multilateral free trade agreements recently. Purchasing power and consumption is growing very quickly in the country. All of these factors provide strong motivation to Polish companies to increase their interest in the Vietnamese market. Matters we could improve include the exchange of information, the level of trust between trading partners, and the opportunities to connect with each other.

■ **What are your thoughts on the impact of the EVFTA on trade and investment cooperation between Poland and Vietnam in the time to come?**

The full text has been published recently and is now waiting for ratification. I believe the FTA will be beneficial for both sides: Vietnam and the European Union, including Poland. Vietnam's entry into the WTO in 2007 contributed to improvements in the country's business climate and thus the

acceleration of its cooperation with the EU. The FTA is the next step and will play a crucial role in our economic cooperation. I believe the agreement is also a way of promoting Vietnam among European citizens and companies. I hope it will also open up new opportunities for Polish investors, since the investment regulations have been quite restricted in the past.

■ **Which industries and sectors in Vietnam will be the most attractive in the eyes of Polish investors after the EVFTA takes effect?**

There are several sectors with potential. Apart from our traditional ones such as mining, shipbuilding, etc., I would add green technologies, not only as a consequence of the EVFTA but overall, remembering Vietnam's engagement in the climate change dialogue and declaration expressed in connection to the COP2015 conference in Paris, like cutting down greenhouse gas emissions and accelerating investments in renewable energy.

Polish companies have very advanced technologies and experience in this field. Among them are ecological solutions in the mining industry, "clean coal technology", and coal gasification, etc. Another field is advanced wastewater treatment technologies and other water management systems, as well as eco-friendly vehicles like electric buses and other public service vehicles.

Polish companies have expressed an interest in the chemical and pharmaceutical industries. Poland's largest chemical group is to open a factory in Thanh Hoa province and other pharmaceutical companies are considering investments in Vietnam as well.

The agro-food sector has

always been among the most lucrative. Cooperation in this field is developing on both sides. Vifon has been in Poland for a long time already (more than 20 years) and Vinamilk opened a branch in Poland in 2014.

■ **What would you recommend to Vietnamese enterprises and organizations seeking investment and cooperation opportunities with Polish investors?**

Be open for cooperation and actively seek new opportunities. I encourage Vietnamese businesses and institutions to attend our events and contact us with any inquiries. We can help them to find the right partner and develop business cooperation. As I said before, I see huge potential for cooperation, in many sectors.

■ **What are the Polish Embassy's plans to promote economic, trade and investment cooperation between Poland and Vietnam this year?**

We are planning several events, mostly in the second half of the year. Activities will include a major Polish food campaign in August in Ho Chi Minh City attended by high level government officials. A separate activity in the Polish meat campaign will be continued, within the framework of the "European meat - tradition, quality and taste" program. Poland's mining industry, with our support, will attend the "Mining Vietnam 2016" exhibition in Hanoi in March.

There are some other Polish Government programs, such as "Promoting the Polish Economy in International Markets", which as well as agro-food includes cosmetics, green technologies, and mining.

Left side shows a 7.400 Wp Grid-tie reference project with storm resistant frame construction. The modules and inverters have been imported from Germany. This system is currently the biggest one in Da Nang City. A 690 Wp Grid-tie reference project with battery storage system has been installed on a Villa (picture above) in Hoi An. Currently these system supplies the whole building (no air-condition installed) incl. garden & water pumps without any grid-connection with electricity from the sun.



We are also finalist of the Proof of Concept (PoC) competition by Vietnam Climate Innovation Center (VCIC) with the project "Solar Powered Boat" that is organized by infoDev and the World Bank Group in partnership with the Asian Development Bank. The concept is to exchange the generator against a photovoltaic system with semi-transparent modules, inverters and a battery bank for energy storage. The stored energy will be enough to supply the vessel with electricity completely independent from the weather conditions and during the night.

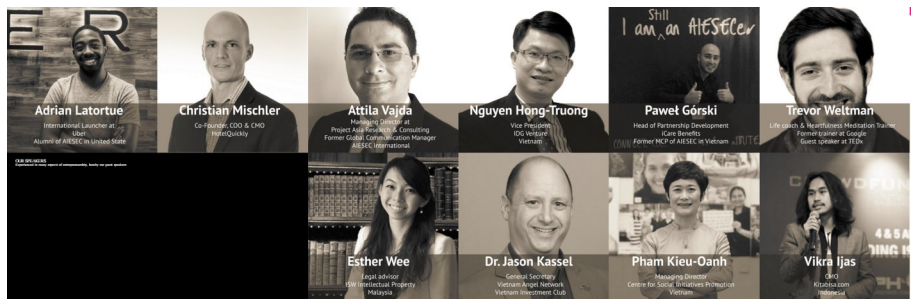

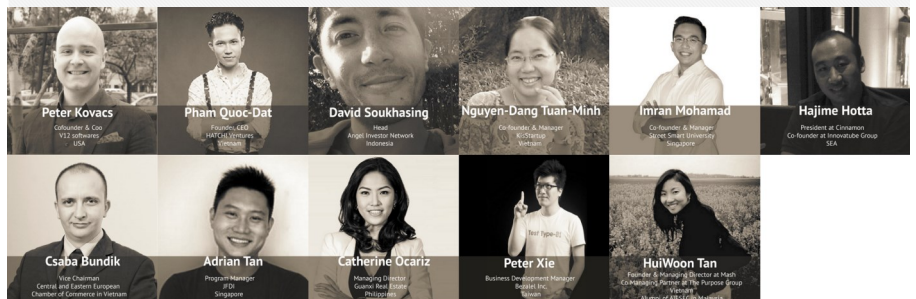
